Fregonese provided a brief overview of the Greenwood 10 acer Urban Growth Boundary expansion project that could potential be a new location for the City's critical facilities. He covered the 8th and Pacific Street new construction site and informed it is up to code and meets setbacks and flood elevation. He mentioned updates on the property located on NW 22nd and stated the duplexes were permitted outright and the access permit was granted by the Port of Tillamook to access NW 22nd from Miller St. He stated the 10-year permit had expired for the Lake Lytle Estates Subdivision and briefed the process of the extension if application was submitted.
