This license issued for temporary business or special event while vending in the City of Rockaway Beach.

RECEIPT

A City business license card will be issued upon receipt of payment to the Rockaway Beach City Hall.

City of Rockaway Beach Ordinance Number 01-366-B (May 9, 2001)

Section 2. License Required. No person shall as owner, operator, principal or as employee or agent of another engage in, prosecute or carry on any business within the city of Rockaway Beach unless or until said person shall have first obtained a business license from the city of Rockaway Beach therefore and paid to the said city the license fee as hereinafter provided

Section 3. Fees. This ordinance shall apply to the businesses, professions, occupations and pursuits hereinafter set forth. The required annual license fee for each business as defined in this ordinance shall be as follows:

- a) July 1 to June 30 \$65.00
- b) Business license obtained after July 1 \$16.25 per quarter to end of year
- c) **Temporary business license (10 days or less) \$5.00 per day**

Section 10. Transfer or Assignment. No transfer or assignment of any license issued hereunder shall be valid or permitted, except that whenever any person shall sell or transfer in whole a business to which such a license has been issued, then the purchaser thereof shall not be required to pay any additional license on said business for the balance of the period covered by said previously issued license, except that in case of such a sale the purchaser shall pay a transfer fee of \$5.00.

Section 12. Penalties. Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof in the municipal court of said city, be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$500.00, or suspension or revocation or by both fine and suspension or revocation of business license.

City of Rockaway Beach Ordinance Number 02-278 (Jun12, 2002)

Section 119. Vending Goods on Streets or Sidewalks: No person shall use or occupy any portion of a street or sidewalk for the purpose of vending goods, wares or merchandise by public outcry or otherwise, unless approval has first been obtained from the City Council.

Section 121. Obstruction of Sidewalks: No person shall place any objects, including but not limited to tables, chairs or sandwich board signs, which reduces the walking pathway to less than four feet.

Section 155. Penalties: Violation of any provision of this ordinance is punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00.
