

RESOLUTION NO. 21 - 967

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY MANAGER TO FINALIZE AND EXECUTE A LAW ENFORCEMENT INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH TILLAMOOK COUNTY

WHEREAS, the City is restructuring how it provides law enforcement services within the City by moving from a City police department to contracting with the County to provide Sheriff patrols within the City; and

WHEREAS, the transition from City law enforcement to County Sheriff patrols will need to take place as soon as feasible due to sudden and unanticipated staffing shortages; and

WHEREAS, the parties have already negotiated many of the terms of a draft agreement and the City Council is aware of the principal terms of the agreement as of this day April 6, 2021, but the agreement is not yet finalized because the County needs more time for its own internal review and approval process; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid a lapse in police coverage and allow for the County's internal review and the timely implementation of the agreement, the City Council wishes to delegate to the Mayor and City Manager the authority to finalize and execute the agreement with the County,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rockaway Beach City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and City Manager to negotiate the finalization of a law enforcement services agreement with the County so long as the principal terms of the agreement remain as disclosed to the City Council on this day, April 6, 2021.
