

Power Outage

Purpose: Provide a safe area, shelter, and basic amenities for the citizens of Rockaway Beach.

Procedure: The following procedure will be implemented in the event of an extended power outage in the City of Rockaway Beach.

1. An extended power outage is defined as an outage that lasts over 6 hours.
2. Once an outage exceeds the 6-hour threshold City Hall will open as a shelter.
3. The Shelter at City Hall will be located downstairs. The Fire Station and Lions Club building may be opened as additional shelter locations as needed.
4. The following will be available in the shelter.
 - a. A warm and lighted area for general use.
 - b. Power to charge cell phones and tablets.
 - c. Information and updates regarding the outage.
 - d. Warm beverages and water.
 - e. Light snacks.
5. Shelter locations will remain open until power is restored.
