This position administers the City's Comprehensive Plan; Performs advanced professional planning work, exercising considerable independent judgment. Responsible for current planning work including permit intake, permit reviews and tasks related to zoning code compliance. Primary responsibilities include coordinating the current planning section, scheduling public hearings, coordinating agendas for Planning Commission, conducting special studies, conducting long range planning studies of complex land use issues to include Comprehensive Plan Review, Public Facilities, Economic Development, Transportation Planning, Citizen Involvement, Land Use and Development Ordinance. Does research, analyzes information, plays a lead role in public outreach efforts, and coordinates selected projects. Work is performed under the direction of the City Manager.

REQUIRES:

Education: Bachelor's Degree in business administration, public administration, urban planning or related field.

Experience: Five years' experience as City Planner, Deputy City Planner, Community Development Director, City Manager, Legal Administrative Assistant, or other applicable experience.
