Seasonal Firefighter Job Announcement

Announcement: Rockaway Beach Fire Rescue is hiring 2 Seasonal Firefighters. Duties include responding to calls for service and maintaining operational readiness. See the job description for details. Positions are open until they are filled.

Department Profile: Established in 1936, Rockaway Beach Fire Rescue boasts a rich history of serving its community. Situated in Tillamook County between Tillamook Bay and Nehalem Bay, Rockaway Beach serves a year-round population of 1,400 residents. The area is a popular tourist destination throughout the year, attracting summer beachgoers and winter storm watchers, with tourist numbers reaching into the thousands on busy weekends. The service area covers approximately 3 square miles, encompassing the City of Rockaway Beach, Nedonna Beach, Twin Rocks, and a 5-mile stretch of coastline.

The Department is currently staffed with a full-time paid Fire Chief, a full-time Firefighter, a Medical Captain, and 12 volunteer firefighters/EMTs. The calls for service are diverse, including first response medicals, structure fires, motor vehicle accidents, brush fires, weather-related emergencies, and surf/water rescues.

Salary Range: This program is grant-funded. Positions available include 40-hour per week roles as well as 10 and 12-hour per diem shifts. The total maximum hours per employee shall not exceed 600 hours for the season. The wage rate is \$22.00 per hour.
