

**Residential Burning Permit
City of Rockaway Beach**

In accordance with ORS Chapter 476.380 to 478.960, and the International Fire Code Chapter 3, a permit for burning has been issued to:

This permit is valid for non-commercial Open Burn/Burn Barrel during daylight hours and under the following conditions:

1. Materials to be burned shall be organic and dry, **NO** garbage, **NO** plastics, **NO** petroleum, or petroleum treated materials **NO** construction or demolition debris, and **NO** material that creates dense smoke or noxious odors.
2. Burn shall be continuously attended by an able-bodied person with a shovel, and garden hose or other sufficient firefighting equipment.
3. All fires must be extinguished at dusk or before if left unattended.
4. Burn Barrels shall have a wire mesh top screen of 5\8" and be on bare ground with no combustibles within 10 feet.
5. Open Pile burning needs to be kept at minimum 10 feet from any combustible materials.
6. All Burning shall STOP if winds increase over 15mph, the air temperature exceeds 75 degrees Fahrenheit, Relative Humidity is below 20%, and\or the burning emits noxious smoke.
7. If a large amount of smoke and/or fire are expected please call the Fire Department at 374-0618 or Tillamook County Dispatch at the non-emergency number 815-3911.

I agree to conform to all applicable City, County and State regulations (including burn bans) regarding burning and assume total responsibility for the safe and proper execution.

I understand that I may personally be held liable for any costs of suppression and/or damage to other property if I fail to control this burn, in addition to criminal citations and penalties. **Send completed burn permit to: cityhall@corb.us or thesse@corb.us for approval**
